Dear Mr. Ryan:

Your letter dated April 11, 2001 raised three questions about our October Quarterly Report. The first issue notes that our Committee made contributions to Representative Stenholm's committee in excess of the limits set forth in the Federal Election Campaign Act. Both contributions were in fact received and reported by the candidate's committee for the general election. We have requested a refund in writing from the Stenholm for Congress committee. Upon receipt of the refund, we will provide the Commission with a copy of the check and will report the receipt accordingly on an upcoming report. We make it a practice to comply with all federal and state laws governing the financial activity of political action committees and have taken steps to insure that such an excessive contribution does not occur again.

In response to your second item, please find the attached amended disbursement Schedule B supporting Line 23 which discloses the office sought, state and congressional district for each contribution reported. (NOTE: We are using the new computerized schedules we submitted for approval in January for filing our Year End Report. We use them here since the activity covered falls only in the year 2000, before the new FEC Form 3X went into effect. Our

next regularly scheduled report will be filed electronically and thus will not use the computerized schedules.)

We appreciate the reminder to include the election designation for each contribution to a federal candidate. You will note that the remainder of the reports filed in 2000 did include this information, and the Committee will be sure to include it in the future as well.
