

Dear Ms. Phillips:

I received your letter today indicating that the \$116,666 owed to the non-federal account should not be financing any activity in connection with federal elections. Please be advised that those funds were made, in both cases, to local mayoral candidates. The first one was a check for \$65,660 to John White for Mayor in 1999, and the second was for \$50,000 for John Street for Mayor in 2004. In each case, the check was sent from the AFSCME PEOPLE fund, was deposited into the account and a check from our account for the same amount was transmitted to the respective mayoral campaigns. Our political action fund did not have the monies to deposit into a non-federal account and that is how the loan came to be. At no time was any money used for any federal election. Thank you for your assistance.

Dear Ms. Morrison:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Schedule D discloses \$116,666 in debts owed to your non-federal account. You are advised that 11 CFR §102.5 prohibits a non-federal account from financing activity in connection with federal elections. Please clarify whether the debts owed to the non-federal account relate to activity conducted in connection with federal elections and if so provide the date(s) when the original activity was conducted. Any payments on debts related to the election or defeat of federal candidates should be allocated accordingly and disclosed as either in-kind contributions on Schedule B supporting Line 23, or as independent expenditures on Schedule E supporting Line 24. 11 CFR §§104.3(b)(3) and 106.1


Although the Commission may initiate legal action regarding the activities conducted by your non-federal account, prompt repayment of the debt and any clarifying information that you provide will be taken into consideration.

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated.

Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
