
Your November 26, 1996 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-Please clarify all expenditures made for Maritime Participation Labor Day Salute on Schedule B. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedule B or E supporting Line 23 or 24 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR §104.3(b) Your response did not clarify whether your promotional announcements were generic in nature or specifically identified federal candidates.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
