This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following item:

- On Schedule H4 supporting Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page, you have checked the Direct Candidate Support category for the payment(s) to "Daily Herald," "The Extra," "Chicago Sun-Times," "The Reader," "Windy City Times" and "WCPT Public Radio" and have disclosed the federal share(s) of this payment as \$3,487.91. Be advised that any federal share in-kind payments, independent expenditures or coordinated expenditures for Direct Candidate Support must also be itemized on Schedule B or E supporting Lines 23 or 24, of the Detailed Summary Page, respectively, and not included in the total for this page. Please amend your report to correct this apparent discrepancy.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
