The TFA Antitrust Compliance Statement was duly noted.

The current financial statement along with the minutes of the February 8, 1994, meeting were distributed. There were no changes.

The first item of business was the fund raiser on September 8, 1994. The trustees took the following action:

The next item of business addressed the issue of Private Property Rights. Ron Hufford reviewed the background on the newest (PPR) coalition in Texas and the movement to keep our members informed of the candidates that support the agriculture community on this issue.

Bob Currie moved that Ron Hufford represent the TFA FORPAC at future meetings of this coalition where candidates for the November election are being discussed and work towards recognizing those candidates that support the U.S. Constitution and the rights of private property owners. Joy Parfurst seconded the motion and it was duly approved. Ron Hufford will keep the Trustees informed on any actions requiring the use of FORPAC recognition.

The possibility of having a joint TFA/LAT Spring meeting in Austin was discussed. Those present were supportive of this possibility.

Constitution and Bylaws of the Texas Forestry Association Political Action Committee (FORPAC)

ARTICLE I. Name

The same of this organization shall be the Texas Forestry Association Perestry Political Action Committee, hardinafter called and referred to as PORPAC, a semprofit and summorporated political organization of persons toterested in forestry in Texas.

ARTICLE II. Purpose

The purpose of FORPAC shall be to promote foresty in Texas and to miss funds for this purpose, and from such funds to make compaling contributions to those seeking election or re-election to state and federal offices without regard to party affiliation, who are believed to be deserving of such support.

ARTICLE III. Regidation

The regulation of the husiness and conduct of the alfales of FORPAC shall. Die determined by its Constitution and Bylaws and rules which may be adopted and amended from time.

ARTICLE IV. Office

The principal office of PORPAC shall be located in Lufkin. Texas.

ARTICLE V. Trustees

- Section 1. The management of FDRPAC shall be vested in five (5) Executive Tressess who are appointed annually by the Texas Forestry Association Producent. The TPA President will also appoint a Chairman from among the appointed Trustees.
- Section 2. The Executive Trustees may appoint from among the contributors in FORPAC, Advisory Trustees to serve at the pleasure of the Executive Trustees. Secti Advisory Trustees shall advise the Executive Trustees, but shall not be voting Trustees.
- Section 3. The Presentive Vice President of the Texas Forestry
 Association will serve as the Executive Secretary, and shall perform the
 administrative functions for the Executive Trusters. The Executive Secretary
 may also serve as Treesturer, and as Campaign Treesturer for the Campaign
 Treasturer Designation filled with the Secretary of State of the State of Texas.
- Section 4. Any Executive Trustees may rasign at any time, by giving written antice to the Presentive Secretary.
- Section 5. Any Advisory Treaten may resign at any close, by giving written notice to the Executive Secretary.
 - Section 6. The Executive Trustees shall appoint from among the

contributors a replacement for any Advisory Trastee who may resign or be unable to serve, if in their discretion, a replacement for such Advisory Trastee is accessary.

Section 7. The Exceptive Trusteen may sol by mamintous expect by seed heliot or telephone without these being the necessity of a meeting, or by a majority vote at a called meeting of at least three (3) Executive Trustees who shall constitute a quotien.

ARTICLE VI.

Operations

- Section 1. There shall be an annual meeting of FORPAC which shall be held at a place convenient to the contributors. Such meeting shall be called by the Rescutive Secretary.
 - Section 2. The operating year for FORPAC shall be the calendar year-
- Section 3. The books and accounts of FORPAC shall be andited by an independent accountant at least once charing such year, a copy of which shall be maintained at the office of FORPAC and available for impossion by any contributor.
- Section 4. The funds of FORPAC shall be maintained in a chacking account in a bank selected by the Executive Treaters. All checks drawn on such account shall require the signature of at least one (1) Executive Treater, together with the signature of either the Chairman, the Treater, or an agent designated for them by the Executive Trustees.
- Section 5. No contributions shall be excepted and no expenditures shall be made from the funds of FORPAC until the Chairman and the Tressurer have been selected, and no contribution shall be secreted and no expenditure shall be made white a vacancy exists in either uffice.
- Section 6. This Constitution and Bylanes may be amunded by the vote of five (5) of the Executive Trustees in order to fulfill the purposes of FORPAC.

We appeave and adopt this Amendment to the Constitution and bytave of FORPAC and confirm the appointment of Tony Bennet, Chairmon, and Rouald 3. Huftord, as Tressurer, Executive Secretary, and Campaign Tressurer, as required under the Political Funds Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1975 (Laws 9175, 64th Lag., ch. 711, p. 2257).
