Mr. Jones:

This letter is in response to the inquiry sent on September 11, 2012, requesting additional information on the following items:

1.On Schedule 5-E of this report, you have not itemized all of the necessary independent expenditure information. Proper disclosure requires the full name and address of the payee, the date, the amount, the aggregate calendar-year-to-date total, the purpose, the election, and the name, office sought, state, and district of the federal candidate supported or opposed by the expenditure. Please amend your report to include the, full name of the payee and presidential primary state.

As we discussed on September 28, 2012, the Sierra Club communicated our endorsement of President Obama through internet communications on April 18, 2012. On April 19th, we filed a 24 hour report given the upcoming primary elections on April 24th. On our call you explained that we must split the costs by each of the remaining primaries. Given that 24 states had upcoming presidential primaries, we were not required to file a 24-Hour report on April 19th as we did not incur expenses of \$1,000 or more with respect to any one of the state primaries.

As a consequence, we will not be amending our 24 hour report, but will amend our July quarterly report to split the costs across the remaining states.

We will also make clearer in our amended quarterly report the name of the payee for the item listed as "Sierra Club".
