Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 items:

1. Line 5(f) indicates that your committee is a nonconnected committee and Line 6 indicates that your committee's "parent" is **Energy Transfer Partners, L.P.** Partnerships or other types of unincorporated associations may sponsor nonconnected committees. However, please note that most forms of support received by a committee from such an organization are considered contributions and subject to the limits, prohibitions and disclosure requirements of 2 U.S.C. §441a(a).

If your committee is not a separate segregated fund because "Energy Transfer Partners, L.P." does not meet the qualifications of a connected organization and there are no other committees or organizations with which you share control or financing, please indicate "**None**" on Line 6. Please amend your Statement of Organization to clarify these apparent discrepancies. 2 U.S.C. §433(b) and 11 CFR §102.2

2. Your committee failed to list a campaign depository on Line 9. Please be advised that each registered political committee must designate a campaign depository or depositories. The committee must maintain at least one checking account or transaction account at one of the depositories. 11 CFR §103.2 Please identify the depository or

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depositories that will be used by your committee. 11 CFR §102.2(a)(1)(vi)

3. Your Statement of Organization does not include an email address for your Committee. Please be advised that beginning January 1, 2007, the FEC will send all courtesy materials to committees exclusively by electronic mail. Courtesy materials include reporting reminders and mailings concerning changes in the law. In addition, mandatory electronic filers are required to provide an electronic mail address, if such an address exists. 11 CFR §102.2(a)(1)(vii) Please amend your Statement of Organization to disclose a current email address.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
