
This statement is in response to the Commission's letter dated December 20, 2015. The Commission requested additional information regarding two items.

First, the Commission requested clarification regarding contributions from individuals or political committees that appear to exceed contribution limits. Upon review by the Committee, most of these individuals and political committees are within their federal limits. Please note that the RFAI lists a \$2,000 contribution from Burger King Franchisee PAC on 9/23/15 and a \$1,000 contribution from PAC of the AAOS on 9/15/15. These contributions were inadvertently recorded as Primary 2016 contributions but were actually designated towards General 2016. The contribution from PAC of the AAOS was for the amount of \$1,500, not \$1,000. The designations and contribution amount will be corrected on an Amended report and the cash on hand will be adjusted accordingly. The rest of the contributions that appear to exceed limits have been refunded, reattributed, or redesignated within the permissible timeframes. These will be reflected on the Committee's Year End Report.

Second, regarding the transfers from joint fundraising committees, the Committee has previously amended its Form 1 Statement of Organization to reflect the joint fundraising representatives. This was submitted to the Senate Office of Public Records along with an Amended Form 2 on October 15, 2015. The Amended Form 2 was posted to the FEC website but the Amended Form 1 was not. The Committee will submit another Amended Form 1 for the FEC's convenience.






