We are in receipt of the letter from the Commission regarding the above referenced report. Please see below for our complete response. Please contact us if any further information is needed.

Our committee does have in place a system that meets the best efforts standard established by the Commission. All of our original solicitations have the request for employer and occupation information on them. For the donors that do not provide that information, we automatically send them a written request for it within 30 days. This follow up does not request any additional monies and contains a self addressed envelope. Finally, we add the new information to our database and include it going forward. Both our original request and the follow up inform the donor that it is a requirement of the federal law that we ask for this information.

The donor in question did temporarily exceed her limit. But, on this same report, the excess portion was refunded. So, due to the immediate refund, this donor has not exceeded her contribution limits for the year. This refund was reported on Schedule B of the 1st Quarter report.

Capitol Hill Lists, LLC is the list broker/manager through which our mailing list is marketed. The fees that they charge are in line with all of the other list brokers in the business. The income received from Capitol Hill Lists is net income from the rentals on our mailing list. The amount that we receive is a net amount, i.e. they have already taken their fees for producing the list rentals that generated the income in the first place. This practice is a very common one in the direct mail business and our entire operation is conducted within the normal and standard practices in the industry.
