Dear Brad:

In reference to your letter dated February 17, 2006:

The contributions from the Good Government Fund and the PSEL PAC for \$2,500 each disclosed on Schedule A were contributions for the judges signing event which occurred in July 2005. The judges who were planning to run for reelection had a signing party to get voter signatures to waive filing fees. The judges and these two organizations made contributions to the Tarrant County Republican Party, and the TCRP wrote checks for their expenses. We were just acting as the bank for this event. The receipts for this event totaled \$13,250. The expenses were \$12,296.18 leaving a balance of \$953.82. This balance has been refunded half each to these organizations. Photocopies of the checks have been mailed to you, and these disbursements will be reflected on the next report.

The Year-End Report does not disclose any payments for salary or wages on Schedule B, Line 30b because federal election activity by our employees that constituted more than 25% of their time ended when the presidential election was over in November 2004. All subsequent payroll has been paid with nonfederal funds.

The \$7,102.98 disclosed on Schedule H3 was for expenses that benefitted our nonfederal account 100%. The \$7,102.98 has been transferred from the federal account back to the nonfederal account, and that disbursement will be reflected on the next report.
