This is in response to your letter dated August 16, 2015 concerning the July Quarterly Report (04/01/2015 - 06/30/2015) of Nancy Pelosi for Congress (the 'Committee').

You have asked about unitemized receipts from individuals/persons other than political committees on line 11(a)(ii). The Committee raises a significant number of low-dollar contributions. None of the donors whose contributions are included on Line 11(a)(ii) of this report exceed \$200 in this election cycle.

You have also asked about itemizing in-kind contributions on Schedule B. The in-kind contributions in question were made by individuals to the Nancy Pelosi Victory Fund, a joint fundraising committee in which Nancy Pelosi for Congress is a participant. When the Nancy Pelosi Victory Fund transferred joint fundraising proceeds to the participants, the Committee reported the attributable portions of these in-kind contributions as a part of the transfer on Line 12 as memo entries. Because these in-kind contributions were made in the first instance to the joint fundraising committee, and hence were part of the joint fundraising transfer, the disclosure was correct. Please note that the Nancy Pelosi Victory Fund disclosed the in-kind contributions as both receipts and disbursements on its own FEC report.
