Line 12, Schedule A, of your report discloses a transfer of funds from a joint fundraiser (Founders Joint Candidate Committee). Line 11(a)(iii), Schedule A, includes itemized receipts from individual contributors that include the notation of (Earmarked Through Founders Joint Candidate Committee). Please be advised that individual entries supporting the amount of earmarked contributions received by a joint fundraiser should not be included in your Schedule A total. Rather, these entries should be recorded as a memo entries on Schedule A. Please amend your report to correct this discrepancy. (11 CFR § 104.3(a)(3))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**
