Receipts for "payroll reimbursements" should be disclosed on Line 15 of the Detailed Summary Page, and itemized on Schedule A when receipts from a single source aggregate greater than \$200 in a calendar year. Please amend your report(s) accordingly.


-Schedule H4 of your report(s) discloses negative expense reimbursements and negative disbursements for refunds of reimbursements from various vendors. Please clarify the exact nature and purpose of these transactions. If these transactions represent actual receipts from these vendors, the receipt should be disclosed on Line 15 of the Detailed Summary Page, and itemized on Schedule A when receipts from a single source aggregate greater than \$200 in a calendar year. Please amend your report(s) accordingly.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this
