This letter is in response to your inquiry dated May 1, 2009 in which you reference the October Monthly Report (9/1/08 – 9/30/08).

1. Schedule E – 48 H Notice Filing

The referenced transaction (Majority Strategies / Landrieu) was filed with the Commission on 9/25/08 (dissemination date – 9/24/08) and is properly reflected on the Commission's website.

2. 48 H Notice – Schedule E Itemization

With regard to the transaction referenced as "Mary Landrieu," the committee disclosed this transaction on Schedule B, Line 21b on the September Monthly report due to the transaction having been paid during the period covered by that report. The committee will amend its September Monthly report to show the transaction on Schedule E, Line 24 to correctly correspond with the subsequently filed 48 H Notice for the same transaction.

The remaining referenced transactions were all disclosed on Schedule E, Line 24 of the September Monthly FEC report due to each transaction having a paid date covered by that reporting period. Therefore, no amendment is necessary.

3. Earmarked Contributions

The transactions referenced were reported either on Schedule A, Line 11a of the September 2008 or the October 2008 FEC reports depending upon when the contribution was received by the committee. The transactions were reported as such because some were received in one period and forwarded in a subsequent period.

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4. 48 H Notices & Schedule E – Differing Dates & Amounts

For each of the transactions referenced, on Schedule E, Line 24, the Committee reported the transactions as of the date paid whereas on the 48 H Notices, the Committee reported transactions within 48 hours of actually disseminating the communication. In addition, the amounts reported on Schedule E and the 48 H Notices were the same. Therefore, no amendment is necessary.

5. Schedule B – Expenditure Clarifications

No portion of the expenditures for “Audio/Video Services,” “Direct Mail Expense,” “Catering,” “Facility Rental,” “Facility Rental/Catering,” “Fundraising Consulting,” “Media Consulting,” “Political Media Consulting,” “Postage,” or “Printing” was made on behalf of any specifically identified federal candidate. These expenditures were made solely on behalf of the Committee. Accordingly, no further itemization is necessary.

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
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
