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Thank you for speaking to me by telephone this morning with regard to the above referenced report.

The contribution which AFSCME, Council 13 Political Action Fund made to our Political Action Fund has been refunded in total. I am enclosing a copy of the letter along with a copy of the check.

Please be advised that it was not our intent to violate any section of the Act. The funds received were not used to influence any federal election, but were used to support a governor's race. That contribution was refunded by the campaign and will be so indicated on the next quarterly report. I have also indicated to AFSCME, Council 13 Political Action Fund that we are not permitted to accept any contribution from them in excess of \$5,000.00 for future reference.

I do intend to be more diligent in reading the regulations issued by the Commission as well as attending the seminars which are periodically offered in an effort to preclude any future errors.
