This letter is submitted on behalf of the International Union of Operating Engineers/ Engineers Political Education Committee ("EPEC") in response to your May 10, 1995 preliminary review of the above-referenced report.

Upon receiving the preliminary review, EPEC contacted the offices of Senators Daniel K. Akaka and Richard H. Bryan to obtain the necessary refunds of the contributions made by EPEC so that the aggregate contributions for the 1994 primary elections for each campaign are in compliance with the \$5,000.00 limit set forth in the Federal Election Campaigns Act, 2 U.S.C. § 441(a)(2)(A). 
Dear Committee:
