
I have received your letter of February 9, 1996, regarding the administrative expenses of the above-referenced nonconnected committee, and report, as I have in the past, the following:

The Committee was formed in 1989, and has not held any organized fund-raising activity since 1990. In the past five years (1991 through 1995), the only significant contribution received was an unsolicited contribution of \$5,000 from the People for John Heinz Committee when it was closed out following the death of Senator Heinz.

With its minimal operating activity, the Committee's need for administrative expenses is virtually non-existent. We do not have an office, utilities, salaries, telephone service or office equipment. While there is a nominal amount paid for operating activities, the small amount of work required for the Committee is performed by volunteers (primarily myself).
