Dear Sir/Madam:

On June 29, 1992, this committee made a transfer in the amount of \$3,000.00 to the general election campaign of Jim Moody, a candidate for the House of Representatives in the fifth district of Wisconsin. Mr. Moody subsequently lost the primary election in that race. On October 30, 1992, this committee received a partial refund of this contribution in the amount of \$544.20. We were advised by Robert H. Friebert, Treasurer of the Friends of Jim Moody Campaign Committee that the remainder of the general election contribution made by us should be reported on Schedule D of FEC Report Form 3X as an obligation owed to our committee. We have been reporting this obligation for more that two years without any further contact from the Friends of Jim Moody Committee.

Pursuant to 11 CFR 116, we hereby ask that the Commission review our request to allow us to forgive this obligation so we may cease reporting the receivable on Schedule D of FEC Report Form 3X. Please advise us of your decision at your earliest convenience. Thank you in advance for your consideration of this matter.
