This is in response to your letter dated June 13, 2001 concerning the 30 Day Post-General Report (10/19/00-11/27/00) of the above-referenced Committee. Our firm has recently been retained to represent the Committee on legal and compliance matters, and the following responses are based on our understanding of the Committee's activities last year.

You have asked the Committee to clarify its expenditures for get-out-the-vote activities. As reported on the Committee's original report, the expenditures were for generic automated telephone calls urging people to vote on Election Day. It is our understanding that no candidates, either federal or nonfederal, were mentioned in the telephone script.

The Committee will amend its report to add the office sought, state and congressional district of its federal contributions. The amendment will be filed under separate cover.

Finally, you ask about the administrative expenses of the Committee. Leadership of Today & Tomorrow is a small committee that has few administrative expenses. Currently, it has no paid staff or rented office space and relies primarily on volunteers to administer the Committee's activities.
