Dear Ms. Lewis:

On behalf of the Arizona Republican Party, and in response to your letter of June 20, 2007, the procedures for obtaining full disclosure for all individuals who contribute in excess of \$200 in a calendar year are as follows:

1. For all contributions, we enter the individual contributor's information into Aristotle, (this occurs within 3 days of receiving any contribution) if it is noted that incomplete information was submitted, then the contributor's information is entered into an Excel spreadsheet for follow up by our Staff.
2. If a telephone number is available, the individual contributor is contacted to obtain the additional information. The information is then added onto the Excel spreadsheet to be input into Aristotle, for the purpose of generating the FEC report.
3. If a telephone number is not available, or we do not make contact by telephone, a form letter is prepared and sent to the contributor within 10 days. A sample copy of the letter is attached herein.
4. If we do not receive a response within thirty days, a second request letter for additional information is sent out to the contributor.

Copies of all correspondence are kept on file as well as the input data on the Excel spreadsheet. We are constantly updating the files during each month as information is received. We are currently awaiting additional information from 38 individual contributors for 2007. This includes all individuals who have made any contribution regardless of the amount.



Dear Mr. Lee:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** Additional information is needed for the following item:

-Commission Regulations require that a committee disclose the identification of all individuals who contribute in excess of \$200 in a calendar year. (11 CFR §104.3(a)(4)(i)) Identification for an individual is defined as the full name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer. (11 CFR §100.12) Your report discloses contributions from individuals for which the identification is not complete.

You must provide the missing information, or if you are unable to do so, you must demonstrate that "best efforts" have been used to obtain the information. To establish "best efforts," you must provide the Commission with a detailed description of your procedures for requesting the information. Establishing "best efforts" is a three-fold process.

First, your original solicitation must include a clear and conspicuous request for the contributor information and must inform the contributor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information. (11 CFR §104.7(b)(1))

Second, if the information is not provided, you must make one follow-up, stand alone effort to obtain this information, regardless of whether the contribution(s) was solicited or not. This effort must occur no later than 30 days after receipt of the contribution and may be in the form of a

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written request or an oral request documented in writing. (11 CFR § 104.7(b)(2)) The request must:

- clearly ask for the missing information, without soliciting a contribution;
- inform the contributor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information, and
- if the request is written, include a pre-addressed post card or return envelope.

Third, if you receive contributor information after the contribution(s) has been reported, you shall either a) file with your next regularly scheduled report, an amended memo Schedule A listing all the contributions for which additional information was received; or b) ~~file on or before your~~ next regularly scheduled reporting date, amendments to the report(s) originally disclosing the contribution(s). (11 CFR §104.7(b)(4))

Please provide the missing information or a detailed description of your procedures for requesting the information. For more information on demonstrating "best efforts," please refer to the Campaign Guide.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
