Dear Ms. Reynolds:

The contributions in question did not exceed the limits set forth in the Act. 2 U.S.C. §441a(a) precludes a multicandidate committee from making a contribution to a candidate for federal office in excess of \$5,000 per election. However, the contributions brought to our attention from the reporting periods listed above were incorrectly disclosed.

Reference #1: The \$1,000 contribution made on 5/23/94 to Randy Tate for Congress was disbursed for the primary election.

Reference #2: The \$3,000 contribution reported on 9/7/94 to La Tourette for Congress Cmte. coupled with the \$3,000 contributed on 9/21/94 made our total contributions in excess by \$1,000. The amount of the check distributed on 9/7/94 was \$2,000. Enclosed are copies of both checks.

On Schedule B Line 23 the correct total disbursements were disclosed.
