

****Form 2 of 2 regarding the July 17, 2007 letter****

Item 3 in the July 18, 2007, letter similarly identifies contributions to a political committee (the New Republican Majority Fund and ERICPAC) which appeared to exceed applicable contribution limits. Again, the two contributions in question were made by the MCI PAC and Verizon PAC prior to their date of affiliation. Each contribution was within applicable contribution limits, and because the contributions were made prior to the date of the affiliation, they were not subject to a shared aggregate limit. We discussed these contributions in our telephone discussion, and you agreed that they are permissible, and no further action is necessary.

Item 4 in the July 18, 2007, letter identifies contributions to candidates that disclose a different candidate name in the "Candidate Name" field (Carper for Senate, Charlie Dent for Congress, Gordon Smith for US Senate, Jim Gerlach for Congress Committee, Joann Davis for Congress Inc., Mel Watt for Congress Committee). As best as we can determine, it appears that these errors were most likely caused by a software problem or user error relating to the system used to process these contributions, since the incorrect names pulled onto the report are all in close alphabetical proximity to the correct names (e.g., Dent/Deal, Watt/Walsh). In an effort to avoid similar problems in the future, we are adding an additional review to our reporting process to help ensure that there are no discrepancies with the committee names versus the actual candidate names. An amendment will be filed reflecting the correct candidate names.
