This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of Failure to adequately respond by the your federal election campaign finances. response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following item:

-Line 6 of your Statement of Organization indicates that "OB-GYNS FOR WOMEN'S HEALTH" and "THE AMERICAN CONGRESS OF OB-GYNS" are the connected organizations for your Committee. Please be advised that a connected organization is any organization which 1) is not a political committee and 2) directly or indirectly establishes, administers, or financially supports a political committee. This type of organization includes a corporation, corporation without capital stock, labor organization, membership organization, a cooperative, or a trade For further guidance on the question of connected organizations, please refer to 11 CFR §100.6.

If your committee is jointly sponsored by these entities, the full names of these organizations must appear in the name of your committee. (See Advisory Opinions 1988-42 and 1988-14) However, if your committee is not jointly sponsored, and one of these organizations represents a parent company or subsidiary of your connected organization, you need not include its name in the name of your committee. 11 CFR §102.14(c) Please provide further clarifying information concerning the relationship between these apparent connected organizations, with regard to your separate segregated fund.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
