I called Tom Riordan Group VP at SPX last Thursday
Riordan left me a VM on Friday agreeing that there had been a disconnect,
that he would personally review the letter of intent and the draft
definitive contracts over the weekend and call back from Germany on Tues or
Wednesday
Jay Carvaello (sp?) (P&L manager, Jeff Nixon's boss) called me this morning
(Wednesday).

I have agreed to resume negotiations with them with three caveats:
a.. Who ever we negotiate with has final authority - if they back-up
again, we will withdraw
b.. The pricing goes back to the letter of intent and no escrow
c.. There must be a clear reasonable-man approach to goals and resources
at SPX that will create training revenue for Sequoia and a continuing
relationship with SPX now and in the future. The SPX definitive agreement
has no assurances, and instead deals with the protection of SPX's rights
should Sequoia not perform. A balance must be struck. I related the Valley
Forge statements about wanting to increase training content in their
business as a reason that we must have assurances from SPX that they are
serious about a training relationship with us.
Jay is designating Jeff Nixon with negotiating authority and Alex will
represent Sequoia.

The next discussion will be early next week when Alex is back. Tim will
talk with Nixon today to get a meeting set up.
