I am responding to your letter of June 3, 1998 to Patricia Ford, Treasurer of the SEIU Committee on Political Education ("COPE"). The SEIU COPE Check No. 0053 in the amount of \$1750.00, dated March 31, 1998, made out to the People for Patty Murray, U.S. Senate Campaign, was improperly designated as a contribution to her primary campaign rather than to her general campaign. 
Thank you for your generous contribution of \$3500 to the People for Patty Murray Campaign committee, check number 0053, dated March 31, 1998.

Federal law limits the amount any one Political Action Committee may contribute to a federal campaign to \$5000 per election. We are currently in the primary election period and are required to attribute all undesignated contributions to this election. With the new contribution, the aggregated amount for the primary election is now \$6750.

We request that you redesignate the \$1750 contribution to the general election by completing the enclosed form and returning it to the People for Patty Murray Campaign in the enclosed pre-paid postage envelope. Because we must receive the redesignation no later than 60 days after receiving the contribution, please return the form to us by May 31, 1998.




