The balance is assumed to be composed of those contributions most recently received by the committee prior to registration. Please identify the source of these contributions on a memo Schedule A. 11 CFR §104.12

report discloses limited payments -Your administrative expenses. Administrative expenses are payments made for the purpose of operating a political including, but not limited to, rent, committee utilities, salaries, telephone service, office equipment and supplies. Any such payments to a person aggregating in excess of \$200 in a calendar year must be disclosed on Schedule B4, supporting Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page. 2 U.S.C. \$434(b)(5) If these expenses being paid by a connected organization, your BIB Statement of Organization must be amended to reflect this relationship. 2 U.S.C. \$433(b)(2) In addition, if expenses have been incurred but not paid in a reporting period, the activity should be disclosed as a debt on Schedule D, if the obligation is \$500 or more, or outstanding for sixty days or more. 11 CFR \$104.11

Any goods or services provided to your committee by a person, except volunteer activity (i.e., a person's time), would be considered an in-kind contribution from that person, and would be subject to the disclosure

requirements of 2 U.S.C. \$434(b)(3) and 11 CFR \$104.13, and the limitations and prohibitions of 2 U.S.C. 55441a and 441b.

Clarification regarding administrative expenses should be disclosed during each two year election cycle beginning with the first report filed in the nonelection year. Please provide the necessary information regarding administrative expenses incurred by your committee and/or amend your report to disclose such expenses according to the referenced provisions of the Act and Commission Regulations.

-Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page discloses joint federal/non-federal operating expenditures during the Committees must itemize reporting period. allocated disbursement made from its federal account or separate allocation account regardless of the amount.
