Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 item(s):

1. The beginning cash balance of this report does not equal the ending balance of your 2021 Year-End Report. Please correct this discrepancy and amend all subsequent report(s) that may be affected by the correction. (52 U.S.C. §30104(b))
2. Schedule B supporting Line 29 of your report discloses disbursements for "ACH Adjustment for fraudulent activity in December 2021 (report on 2021 YE report)," "ACH Dispute Adjustment (fraudulent activity reported to bank and refunded in same quarter)," "ACH Dispute Adjustment (fraudulent charge reported to bank and refunded in same quarter)," "Fraudulent Activity (reported to bank and awaiting refund)," "Fraudulent Activity (reported to bank and refunded in Q2)," and "Fraudulent Activity (reported to bank and refunded in same quarter)" totaling \$3,455.16. This transaction(s) appears to be related to an apparent unauthorized disbursement of Committee funds. Although the Commission may take further legal action regarding this apparent improper use of Committee funds, any further clarifying information that you can provide will be taken into consideration. (11 CFR § 102.9, 102.15, and 104.3)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an

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enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
