

Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:



Please clarify the current status of these loans and disclose the current terms and conditions if the loans were renegotiated. Also, if the loan(s) was from personal funds, please acknowledge that fact in an amendment to this report. It is important to note that "personal funds" is strictly defined by Commission Regulations. See 11 CFR §110.10. (11 CFR §§100.7(a)(1), 104.3(d) and 104.18(h)) Note that an overdue bank loan may be considered a prohibited contribution by the bank or lending institution. Note that an overdue loan from the candidate's personal funds may be considered a contribution from the candidate if new terms are not disclosed. (11 CFR §§100.7(b)(1) and 104.3(d))

-Schedule D of your report fails to supply certain information. Commission Regulations require the full name and address of each creditor, the outstanding beginning and ending balances, any amount incurred during this reporting period, any payment made during this reporting period and the nature or purpose of each debt. All debts must be reported until extinguished or settled. Please amend your report to include the purpose of the debt to PSE&G. (11 CFR §104.11)
