PEF endorses candidates in more

The PEF Executive Board has endorsed the political candidates reported here for the September 13 primary and November 6 general elections. In some districts, no candidates were endorsed, as noted below.

The endorsements are based on PEF's interviews and reviews of individual candidates' voting records and qualifications, followed by recommendations from PEF's regional and statewide political action committees (PACs).

"No single vote or action determined our decision to make an endorsement of any specific candidate," said PEF President Susan Kent. "Rather, we looked

at the candidate's record in protecting PEF members' and other union members' job security.

"We must make our elected representatives in Washington and Albany understand they cannot take PEF's endorsement for granted," Kent said. "Our endorsement must be earned. It is not automatic and it is not a rubber stamp. We endorse candidates who support our positions on the issues and who are willing to stand up for those positions when the chips are down."

"I heartily agree with PEF Region 12 Coordinator Connie Batts who said, 'We need to return to being a force to be reckoned with. Our collateral is ourselves. We need to get our boots on the ground

and work hard for the candidates we endorsed. Now is our time,'" Kent said.

Get involved, vote

"I urge all of our members to make sure they are registered to vote and to make the time and effort to go to the polls September 13 if they are enrolled in a party that has a primary," said PEF Vice President Wayne Bayer, who now chairs the union's statewide political action committee.

He also urged members to contact their regional coordinators or PAC chairs to volunteer and campaign for the endorsed candidates.

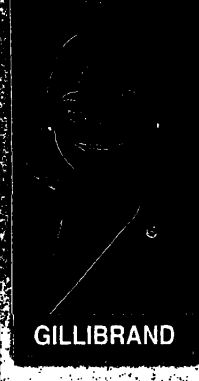

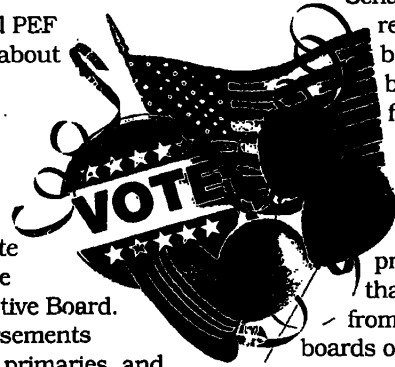
