Dear Mr. Gibson,

This letter and its enclosures are filed in response to the subject inquiry, a copy of which is provided as enclosure (1) to this letter. We had believed that the very detailed explanation we provided in our prior response was a sufficiently detailed explanation of the values questioned in the report at issue, and that our response was therefore complete. Enclosures (2) and (3) are provided to comply with the requirements detailed in the immediate inquiry. Only the 30-Day Post Election and Year-End Reports were affected by the changes ordered in your letter. The first pages of each report are unchanged from those submitted originally, and they are provided solely for the purpose of clarifying which data are being amended. The respective Detailed Summary Pages reflect the actual changes.

Although we have complied fully with the changes you requested, we are deeply concerned about the data that result. First, line 18 of the Detailed Summary Page is intended to account for all transfers from the Non-Federal account to the Federal account to reimburse the Non-Federal share of allocated expenses. After amending our line 21(a)(ii) data as required, the non-Federal share of allocated costs differs from the line 18 transfers by \$31,855.91. The provisions of 11 FEC 106.6 suggest, however, that these values should be equal. Specifically, 11 FEC 106.6(c)(1) states that the entire amount of an allocable expense must be paid from the Federal fund and that funds shall be

transferred from the Non-Federal fund *solely* to cover the Non-Federal share of the allocable expenses. Yet our Non-Federal expenses, as shown on line 21(a)(ii) [\$37,949.45], are greatly exceeded by the transfers from the Non-Federal fund as shown on line 18 [\$69,803.36] on our Year-End Report.

Our second concern is that the amended cumulative line 21(a)(ii) Non-Federal expenses [\$37,949.45], as a percentage of Total Shared Activity Expenses [\$303,492.81], is 12.50%, and does not accord with the final ratio of 77%/23% reported on Schedule H1, where the latter represents the Non-Federal percentage based on our actual candidate support as required under the Commission's rules. Conversely, our original report was consistent in that our line 21(a)(ii) value [\$69,803.38] equaled 23% of the Total Shared Activity Expenses.

The requirement to commence electronic filing shortly prompts our third concern. When a PAC revises its funds expended on Schedule H1 during the course of a given year, FEC reporting software sponsored by VOCUS and Gnossos retroactively revises all expenditure splits from the start of the year to the date of the revision. This forces the restatements of lines 21(a)(i) and 21(a)(ii) that appeared in our original report. While one may affect the restatements you have ordered manually, we are unaware of any method by which one may achieve such compliance electronically. Since the Commission's rules prescribe the initial use of estimated candidate support experience as a basis for allocating expenditures, and require subsequent revisions to reflect actual candidate support experience as it becomes known, it is inevitable that restatements will be necessary. However, our research of existing Commission guidance does not reveal how a PAC may freeze its initial allocation experience so that it is not superseded retroactively by a subsequent revision when filing electronically.

So that we may avoid future issues when we revise our basis for allocating shared expenditures, we request specific written guidance that allays the three concerns detailed above. Dear Mr. Forsythe:

On March 13, 2001, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your March 19, 2001, response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-Your response states that the mathematical discrepancies on Lines 21(a)(i) and 21(a)(ii), Column B occurred as result of a change in your allocation ratios during the 30 Day Post-General Reporting Period and that applying the adjusted ratio to previous reports, your current Column B totals are correct. Please be advised that you should amend any necessary reports to reflect adjusted line totals. Furthermore, you still need to correct Lines 21(a)(i), 21(a)(ii) and 31, Column B of the Detailed Summary Page. You should add the "Calendar Year-to-Date" total from your previous report to the current "Total This Period" figure from Column A to derive the correct Column B totals. Please amend this report and any subsequent reports that may be affected by this correction.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by April 25, 2001. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by

this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
