Dear Ms. Maupin:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-The Summary Page discloses \$8,652.22 on Line 7, but the Detailed Summary Page shows the Line 31 total to be \$0. These figures should be the same. Please amend your report accordingly.

-Your calculations for Line 8, Columns A and B appear to be incorrect. FEC calculations disclose this amount(s) to be \$3,078.85. Please provide the corrected total(s) on the Summary Page.

-Please clarify all expenditures made for "Fundraising Expense/ Invite Printing," "Fundraising Expense/ Postage for Invites, etc.," "Fundraising Expense/ Printing," "Administrative/ Printing," "Fundraising Expense/ buttons," "Fundraising Expense/ stickers," "Fundraising Expense/ T-Shirts," "Fundraising Expense- Booth Fee," "Fundraising Expense/ Food and Beverage," "Fundraising Expense/ Reimbursement for Wine," and "Fundraising Expense/ Wine Reimbursement" on Schedule(s) B. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedules B or E supporting Lines 23 or 24 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR §§104.3(b) and 106.1

-Schedule C discloses a loan from Vandenberg Communications for the amount of \$5,466.66. However, it appears that the disclosed activity may have been incorrectly reported. If the activity is a debt or obligation owed to a vendor, it should be properly disclosed on Schedule D, supporting Line 10 of the Summary Page.

Commission regulations require that debts and obligations owed by the reporting committee must include the full name and mailing address of each creditor, the amount of the debt outstanding at the beginning of the reporting period, the amount of the debt incurred this period, the payments this period to retire the debt, the outstanding balance at the close of the reporting period and the nature or purpose of the debt. Additionally, all debts must be reported continuously until extinguished or settled. If you have incorrectly reported this activity, please amend your report by providing a Schedule D.

If the activity was correctly reported as a loan, please amend Schedule C by providing the date incurred, date due, and interest rate. The loan schedule (Schedule C) should disclose the following information: the name and mailing address of the person making or receiving the loan, original amount, cumulative payment, outstanding balance, date incurred, date due, and interest rate for all loans that your committee has received. 11 CFR §§104.3(d) and 104.11(a)

-2 U.S.C. §434(b)(3) requires itemization of contributions from individuals and persons other than political committees, where the aggregate total from the contributor exceeds \$200 in a calendar year. In addition, 11 CFR §104.3(a)(2)(i)(B) requires a committee to report the total amount of unitemized contributions (see Line 11(a)(ii) of the Detailed Summary Page). If a committee wishes to disclose contributions regardless of the amount contributed, the committee must separate (on separate receipt schedules) those contributors requiring itemization from those who are not required to be itemized. 11 CFR §104.3(a)(4)(i) For future filings, please submit your reports in this order.

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
