Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended. Please amend your report by providing the name, date, amount, and purpose for such payments as required by 11 CFR §102.9(b)(2)(i)(A).
