Dear Mr. Chambers:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-It appears that you may have deducted for certain operating expenditures twice, deflating the available cash on hand for the committee. Schedule B-P of your report supporting Line 23 reports several voided checks that the committee issued new checks for. The committee reported the voided checks as memo entries, yet reported the replacement checks as actual disbursements. Since the memo entries do not add the amount of the voided checks into the committee's cash on hand, reporting the replacement checks as disbursements duplicates the previously reported payment. Please file an amendment to your report to correct this discrepancy, and all subsequent reports that may be affected by this correction.

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
