This FEC Form 99 is filed by America 2.0 PAC (the "Committee?") in response to your request dated March 4, 2020 for additional information regarding the Committee's 2019 Mid-Year FEC Report.

The Committee has reviewed each of the contribution records listed in the attachment to your letter. Item 1 of your letter notes that the Committee reported contributions from an individual that appear to be in excess of applicable contribution limits. As your letter notes, the Committee issued a \$5,000 refund to the donor in question on July 7, 2019, which was reported on the Committee's Year-End 2019 Report (Transaction ID: 500018939). The Committee initially intended to obtain a reattribution from the donor of the excessive portion of their contribution, which led to a delay in refunding the excessive portion. Once it became clear that a reattribution would not be obtained, the Committee refunded the donor.

Item 2 of your letter asks about receipts from Tim Ryan for America, the authorized campaign committee of Congressman Ryan's presidential campaign. These payments were not contributions to America 2.0, but payments for goods or services provided on behalf of Tim Ryan for America. Given Tim Ryan for America's payment to the Committee, no excessive contribution occurred. Advisory Opinion 2004-37 at 2, 4 (Waters). To clarify the public record, the Committee has amended its Mid-Year Report to reflect these receipts as offsets to operating expenditures.
