Reference Mid Year Report (1/1/09-6/30/2009) Response to November 6 RFA

This ETEXT ATTACHMENT is in response to the above referenced letter. The paragraphs below respond to the FEC letter which requested clarification on 2 items.

1. The letter asked if our committee was assessed the usual and normal charge for the goods and or services and we were asked to explain the steps the political committee took in determining the amount charged.

Payments made by the Senate Majority Fund to the Jon Kyl for US Senate committee are based on fair market value of the service provided.

The services provided are rent of office space, rental of office equipment, and reimbursement for telephone and internet services. Rent of office space is based on square footage used exclusively by each committee and the frequency of use of common areas.

Office equipment rental is based on fair market value of equipment of equivalent age on the general market; ie: a desk, a chair, filing cabinets, and proportional use of computer equipment, copier and fax machine.

Reimbursement for telephone and internet is based on percentage of use by each committee. Currently, these items are running at fifty/fifty for each committee. Employees of the Senate Majority Fund are paid on an hourly basis by the Senate Majority Fund. These payments made

to Jon Kyl for US Senate were the usual/normal charges for goods and or services.

2. Schedule B Line 23 showed a contribution to Friends of John McCain, 900 Second Street, Washington DC 20002, which is his Senate Reelection Committee not his Presidential Committee. The contribution was made to his Senate Reelection Committee. I made a data entry error when I entered the 'Candidate Name/Office Sought' part of the form. Senate should have been marked instead of President.

The address and Federal ID number for Friends of John McCain shows that the contributions went to and were meant for his Senate Campaign not his Presidential Campaign. The error was made in the designation of 'Office Sought' in the form. I amended our report to show 'Senate' instead of 'President'.
