Dear Mr. Morse:

This response is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of Summit PAC's October Quarterly Report covering the period of 7/1/06 thru 9/30/06. As the Commission's November 22, 2006 correspondence references, Schedule B of that report disclosed three contributions that exceed the contribution limits set forth in the Act.

The three excessive contributions in question were made in error, and a request for a refund of the excessive amounts has been made from each of the recipient committees. Copies of those requests are included herewith, and providing that they're received before December 31, 2006, the respective refunds will be disclosed on Schedule A supporting Line 16 of the Year End report, due on January 31, 2007.

The Commission's correspondence also references the rules pertaining to the disclosure of administrative expenses, including the rules on expenses paid by a connected organization, expenses that have been incurred but not paid, and the disclosure of in-kind contributions. Those rules have been carefully reviewed, and this will verify that all of the administrative expenses incurred by Summit PAC- which historically consist almost entirely of compensation for services- have been disclosed in accordance with those rules.

Summit PAC respectfully requests that its prompt action in correcting the mistake be taken into consideration in regards to enforcement action.
