Dear Mr. Willburn:

On September 4, 1996 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your September 10, 1996 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-Schedule B supporting Line 23 of your report discloses a contribution(s) to a candidate(s) for the 1996 primary elections; however, the funds were disbursed after the 1996 primary election date. Please note that contributions may not be designated for an election which has already occurred unless the funds are to be used to reduce a candidate committee's debts incurred during that election campaign. Please clarify the \$1,000 contribution to Dan Williams (ID) on 6/18/96 and disclose any redesignations or refunds as necessary on the appropriate schedules.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
