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This responds to your request for additional information about the February monthly report regarding the \$50,000 disbursement to Colksy Media on January 9, 2012. When Our Destiny PAC transmitted the wire to its media buyer for \$150,000 on January 9, 2012, it thought that this full amount was for the New Hampshire primary. Because the primary was held on January 10, 2012, the expenditure was made less than 24 hours prior to the date of the election, and therefore no 24-hour report was required. Subsequently, when filing the amended February Monthly report addressing your previous RFAI, Our Destiny PAC realized that \$50,000 of that wire was allocated to media buys in South Carolina. When filing the amended report, the PAC made certain to break out that \$50,000 for South Carolina to improve transparency. As noted in prior RFAs and amended reports, the state in which the communication was to be disseminated had not initially been included, which Our Destiny PAC has rectified in other amendments. Filing a 24-hour report at the time it made the discovery after the South Carolina primary and after Governor Huntsman had dropped out of the race did not seem to increase transparency in any way. Moreover, Governor Huntsman actually dropped out of the race shortly after the buy was made and many of the advertisements did not run. Subsequent reports have shown refunds as they were received.

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
