The \$2,500 contribution was – in view of the fact that it came well after the Illinois primary – intended for candidate Baker's general election campaign.

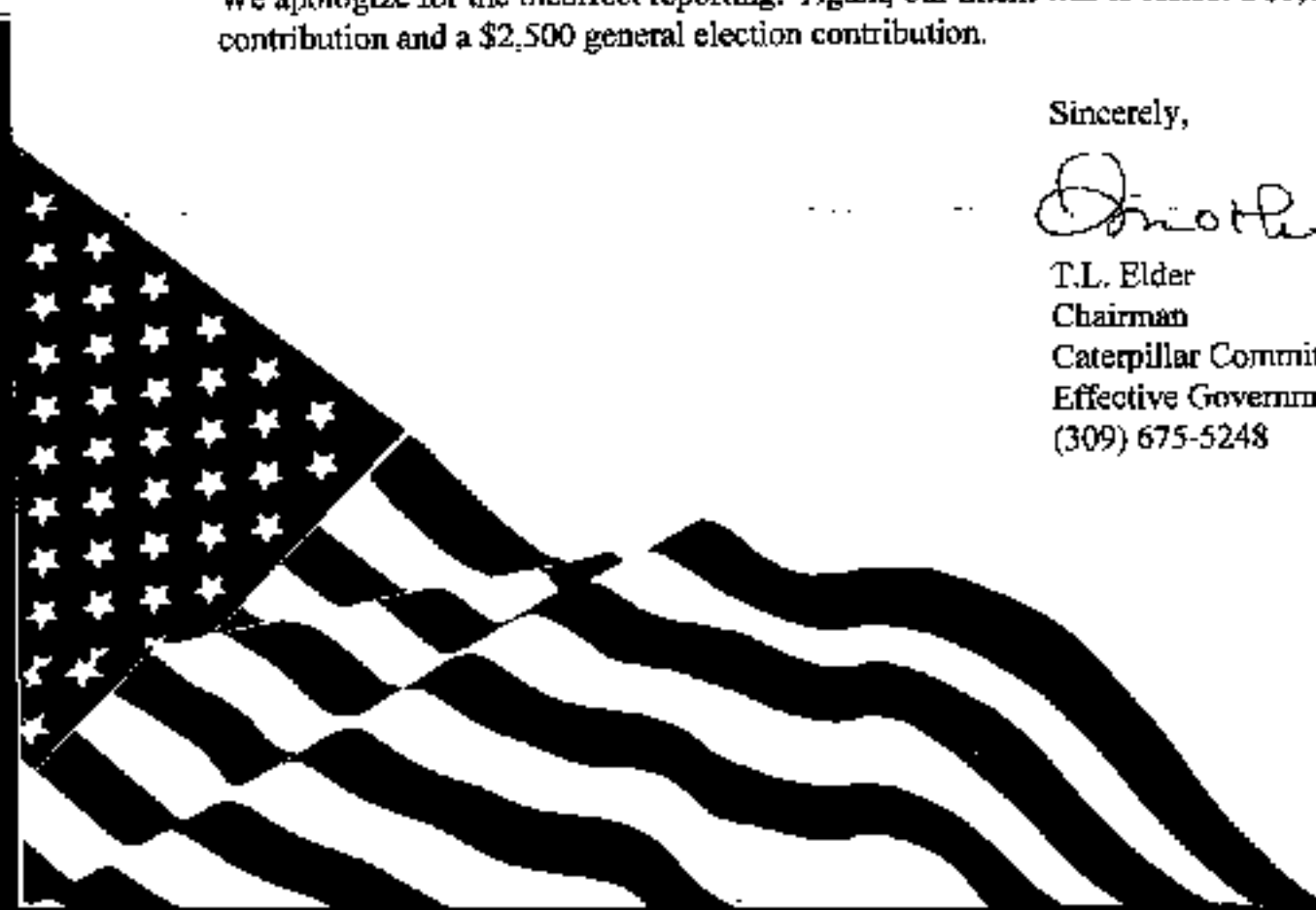
As a result, there remains an opportunity for the Caterpillar Committee for Effective Government to make an additional \$2,500 contribution to Mr. Baker's general election campaign.
