This memo pertains to the letter sent October 27, 2006 requesting additional information on the following items:

In response to your first inquiry, the independent expenditures that Sierra Club Political Committee made on behalf of Lincoln Chafee are properly categorized as independent and therefore are correctly reported on Schedule E. These expenditures were not coordinated, as that term is defined in section 109.20 of the FEC's regulations, with any candidate, candidate's committee, political party committee or their agents.

In response to your second inquiry, all Sierra Club Political Committee solicitations request the occupation and the employer of the contributor. If the information is not received at the time of the request, we send the following letter within thirty days:

Thank you for your contribution to Sierra Club Political Committee, we appreciate your support!

Federal law requires political committees to report the name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer for each individual who contributes more than \$200 in a calendar year. Please help us comply with that requirement by providing the information requested below and returning this letter in the envelope provided. If you have no employer and are retired, self-employed, etc., please so state.

SCPC is a political committee. Unless otherwise notified, 100% of your contribution will be applied to your contribution limit under federal law. Contributions to SCPC are entirely voluntary. SCPC cannot accept contributions from corporations (including professional corporations), or from individuals who are not United States citizens or permanent residents.

Again, thank you for your support of Sierra Club Political Committee.

When we receive this information, we enter it into Schedule A as a memo text in the next report. The committee also discloses any information that it or the Sierra Club possesses in records or prior reports in the same election cycle.

Finally, we have amended our September report to clarify the description on Schedule H4 from "Pennsylvania State Predictive Model" to "Voter Modeling."
