Dear Ms. Enright:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the notice referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-The sum of memo Schedules 9-A supporting the transfer from the joint fund-raising committee, Victory Campaign 2004, should be greater than or equal to the amount reported. Each participating committee shall report its share of net proceeds received from the joint fundraising committee. Each committee shall also file memo schedules 9-A itemizing its share of the gross receipts as contributions from the original donors. Please amend your report to correct this discrepancy. (11CFR§102.17(c)(8)(i)(B))


-Schedule 9-A of your report discloses an in-kind donation. Please clarify the specific nature of this donation. (11CFR§104.13(a)(1) and (a)(2))

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure

to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
