This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 items:

1. Commission records indicate that your committee is a separate segregated fund; however, you have checked Line 5(h) which indicates that your committee is a joint fundraising representative. Please be advised that a separate segregated fund is a political committee established, financed, maintained or controlled by a corporation, labor organization, membership organization, cooperative or trade association.

If your committee is a separate segregated fund, an amended Statement of Organization should be submitted which indicates the appropriate Type of Committee and Connected Organization on Line 5(e). Please amend your Statement of Organization to clarify this discrepancy. 2 U.S.C. §433(b) and 11 CFR §102.2

2. Please clarify your relationship, if any, with "Eaton Corporation," which appears to be your connected organization. For further guidance on the question of connected organizations, please refer to 11 CFR §100.6. Also, you are advised that Line 6 should be used to disclose the name of your connected organization (not the apparent name of your PAC). Please amend your Statement of Organization to clearly identify the official name of your connected organization on Line 6.
