On August 19, 1998, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.


Your August 25, 1998 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-You have failed to clarify the apparent excessive contribution to the Hollings for Senate committee. Your letter clarifies the relationship of ANTEC to Anixter International; however both contributions were made by ANTEC PAC after Anixter had sold the controlling stock to ANTEC. Commission records show that the two contributions were made by the same committee, ANTEC Political Action Committee, ID C00221986. 2 U.S.C § 441 a(a) precludes a multicandidate committee from making a contribution to a candidate for federal office in excess of \$5,000 per election. Please clarify any corrective action taken with regards to the contributions in question.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
