Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 item(s):

1. Line 6(a) of the Summary Page represents the total cash-on-hand as of January 1, 2011. Line 6(b) represents the cash on hand at the beginning of the reporting period. These two figures should be the same for the first report of the year. Please clarify this discrepancy and amend any subsequent report(s) that may be affected by this correction. (2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(1) and 11 CFR §104.3(a)(1))
2. The totals listed on Line(s) 6(c), 7, 11(a)(ii), 11(a)(iii), 11(d), 19, 20, 23, 31 and 32, Column B of the Summary and Detailed Summary Page(s) appear to be incorrect. Column A and Column B totals should be the same on the first report of the calendar year. Please file an amendment to your report to correct the Column B discrepancies for this report and all subsequent report(s) which may be affected by this correction. Note that Column B should reflect only the Calendar Year-to-Date totals. (2 U.S.C. § 434(b))
3. Line 23 of the Detailed summary Page of your report discloses a total of \$0 in contributions to federal candidates and committees. The sum of the entries itemized on Schedule B, however, indicates the total to be \$1,350. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy. (11 CFR § 104.3(a) and (b))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
