Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 item(s):

1. On Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) of the Detailed Summary Page, your report disclosed contributions from individuals that omit the aggregate year-to-date totals. Please amend your report to provide the missing information. (11 CFR §104.3(a)(4))
2. Your Amended 30 Day Post-General Report (10/18/12 - 11/26/12), received 2/14/13, discloses a substantial increase in the amount of disbursements from those disclosed on your original report. The Commission notes the memo text attached to your report stating, in part, "Four checks were omitted from the 12 day Pre General Election report due to a clerical error" and "Seven checks were previously reported in the 12 day Pre General Election report but were issued on October 18, not on October 17 as reported. As these disbursements did not leave control of the PAC until October 18, they should have been reported in the 30 day POST-Election report and have been removed from the Pre General Report and included in an amended POST-Election report." Although the Commission may take further legal action concerning this matter, your clarification and any additional clarification you may have will be taken into consideration. 11 CFR §104.3

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this

matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
