On June 4, 1997 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.


Your June 23, 1997 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-Your response states that your \$1,000 contribution made on December 3, 1996 to Team Emerson was for debt retirement. This contribution was made after the General Election to a committee which reported no debts throughout the 1996 election cycle. You should notify the recipient committee in writing of your redesignation of the contribution; or, request a refund. Please inform the Commission of your corrective action in writing and provide a photocopy of the redesignation or refund request.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
