Dear Ms. Mattoon:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Your calculations for Line 21(c), Columns A and B appear to be incorrect. FEC calculations disclose this amount(s) to be \$69,455.45 and \$322,399.88. Please provide the corrected total(s) on the Detailed Summary Page.

-Your calculations for Line 30, Columns A and B appear to be incorrect. FEC calculations disclose this amount(s) to be \$122,100.95 and \$512,929.30. Please provide the corrected total(s) on the Detailed Summary Page.

-The Summary Page discloses \$122,100.95 on Line 7, Column A, but the Detailed Summary Page shows the Line 30, Column A total to be \$135,955.45. These figures should be the same. Please amend your report accordingly.

-The Summary Page discloses \$512,929.30 on Line 7, Column B, but the Detailed Summary Page shows the Line 30, Column B total to be \$533,339.92. These figures should be the same. Please amend your report accordingly.

-On Schedule H2, you disclose the ratio for "May 1 Louisiana Luncheon"


and "May 2 District of Columbia fundraising dinner" to be the same as previously reported; however, it appears that this activity/event was not previously reported. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

-On Schedule H4 supporting Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page, you have failed to include a unique identifying title or code for the payment(s) made to Joseph Boland, Aaron Chang, JAG Associates, John McGovern, Scott Palmer, Luke Stedman, and Mike Stokke. 11 CFR §104.10. Please amend this report to provide a unique identifying title or code for each entry omitting this information.

-Your EVENT YEAR-TO-DATE calculations for "May 1 Louisiana Luncheon" and "May 2 District of Columbia fundraising dinner" are incorrect. EVENT YEAR-TO-DATE totals for administrative and voter drive costs are derived by aggregating all disbursements during the calendar year for the whole Administrative/Voter Drive category. EVENT YEAR-TO-DATE totals for fundraising, direct candidate support, and exempt activities are derived by aggregating all disbursements during the calendar year within a specific event. These should be calculated by adding the latest disbursement for a category or event to the previous EVENT YEAR-TO-DATE total for that category or event. This running EVENT YEAR-TO-DATE total should be disclosed after each disbursement is listed. Please amend your report by providing the correct EVENT YEAR-TO-DATE totals.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
