
Dear Ms. Jones

The Campaign for Working Families (FEC ID# C00325076) is in receipt of your letter dated December 23, 2003, regarding our mid-year FEC Report.

Concerning occupation and employer information, enclosed please find a sample committee solicitation. This solicitation, like all our solicitations, informs the donor that the committee is required to report the information, and asks the donor to provide it.

In addition, please find another sample of the letter we send to those donors whose aggregate cycle to date contribution exceeds \$200, but who do not provide us with their occupation and employer information when they send their contribution. We believe that this follow-up letter, which is sent out within thirty days of receipt of the contribution, fulfills the "stand alone" provision in the regulations. A pre-addressed envelope (sample enclosed) is included with each follow-up request. All such information is reported. In this manner, the committee believes that it is meeting the best efforts provisions outlined in your letter.

Dear Mrs. Livingston,

I need your help.

I am leading the battle to protect our First Amendment right -- and I need you to join me.

Will you please sign the enclosed Petition to protect our First Amendment right to freedom of religion and return it to me today?

And when you return your signed Petition, will you also enclose your most generous contribution of \$300, \$225 or \$150 to Campaign for Working Families to help me stand up for our rights?

The radical left is interpreting the First Amendment as freedom *from* religion, when in reality it reads freedom *of* religion.

And this most recent decision over the Ten Commandments is the last straw.

Mrs. Livingston, I have enclosed a Citizen Petition to your Representative urging them to pass the Ten Commandments Defense Act of 2003 which I ask you to sign and return to me.

Like me, I'm sure you followed the Ten Commandments story in Montgomery, Alabama this past August. In July of 2001, Alabama Chief Justice Roy Moore installed a concrete monument of the Ten Commandments in the rotunda of the Alabama Supreme Court building.

The Ten Commandments, after all, are the moral law which formed the basis of our judicial system. God gave us these rules to help us live with one another.

But this past August, the monument was ordered to be removed by the federal court and then agreed upon by eight of nine justices on the Alabama Supreme Court -- but Justice Moore defied the order to remove the monument.

Despite a week of protests from thousands of Christian supporters, the monument was removed and Justice Moore was suspended from the bench on "ethics" charges.

Mrs. Livingston, I need your help, because even though the monument was taken down, the battle rages on.

Please sign the enclosed Petition urging your Representative to vote for the Ten Commandments Defense Act of 2003 (H.R. 2045) sponsored by Rep. Rob Aderholt of Alabama.

This legislation would reaffirm the right of states to display the Ten Commandments on

public property under the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution which states: "The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people."

The bill would even go a step further by limiting the jurisdiction of the federal courts to hear cases seeking the removal of such displays. Congress has the authority to limit the courts' jurisdiction and it's time they exercised their authority to reign in our rogue courts.

Because frankly, our liberal court system is out of control!

Whether it's prayer in public schools, banning the Ten Commandments, removing God from the Pledge of Allegiance, or inverting "rights" to partial-birth abortion and homosexual sodomy, unelected judges have shown incredible disdain for public opinion, majority rule and the laws written by our elected representatives.

The courts have attacked our families, they have attacked our schools, they have attacked our children and now they are attacking the Word of God – and that's where I draw the line.

Opponents to the monument cite the First Amendment and the "separation of church and state", but the First Amendment was not designed to keep public buildings Bible-free, but rather to keep the federal government from establishing a national church.

In spite of forty years of lectures and lies from America's cultural elites about the "separation of church and state," Americans still understand that our Founders never intended for faith to be censored from the public square.

In fact, our Founding Fathers were Christians that came to America because they were not allowed to practice their religion freely.

In oppressive regimes, such as China, the first thing they do is restrict one's right to worship as they please and that is exactly what these liberal judges are doing!

Most politicians hate the cultural issues that stir up such strong emotions. They will do virtually anything to avoid them. Yet in spite of the best laid plans of politicians, this hot button issue will not go away.

We've seen it in other states. Just this summer, in Adams County Ohio, the Ten Commandments were ordered to be removed from four public high schools. And the ACLU has cases pending in Kentucky, Tennessee, Utah and North Carolina to stop displays of the Ten Commandments.

I promise you that Campaign for Working Families will play a major role on this issue with your continued help.

As I have mentioned before, this is not a single issue, but rather a dangerous trend of liberal activists using our court system to inflict their radical views on the public. The voice of a few are changing the lives of all.

**It is time for the people's elected representatives to reign in our rogue courts.**

The Founding Fathers argued in the Federalist Papers that the judiciary should be, by its very nature, the "least dangerous" branch of government; *that the supreme power of the republic rested not with the Supreme Court, but in the Congress.* Yet over time, the courts have usurped so much power that unelected judges regularly act as "robed masters," creating and rewriting the law at whim.

But we can't continue to do that without your help.

In essence, the liberals are using the courts for movement on their issues, while conservatives remain silent.


Well, I'm not willing to be silent any longer. With the recent legal victories won by the radical ACLU, it is critical that H.R. 2045 pass.

in Support of The Ten Commandments Defense Act of 2003 (H.R. 2859)

**Issued To: Representative Dennis J. Hastert**

The First Amendment to the Constitution of the United States secures rights against laws respecting an establishment of religion or prohibiting the free exercise thereof made by the United States Government.

The Declaration of Independence declares that governments are instituted to secure certain unalienable rights, including life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness, which all human beings are endowed by their Creator and to which they are entitled by the laws of nature and of nature's God.

The Tenth Amendment reserves to the States respectively the powers not delegated to the United States Government nor prohibited to the States.

The power to display the Ten Commandments on or within property owned or administered by the several States or political subdivisions should be declared to be among the powers reserved to the States respectively.

The expressions of religious faith by individual persons on or within property owned or administered by the several States or political subdivisions thereof is hereby declared to be among the rights secured against laws respecting an establishment of religion or prohibiting the free exercise of religion made or enforced by the United States Government or by any department or executive or judicial officer thereof; and declared to be among the liberties of which no State shall deprive any person without due process of law made in pursuance of powers reserved to the States respectively.

I urge you to Vote "YES" on The Ten Commandments Defense Act of 2003.
