Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 items:

1. Schedule A supporting Line 15 of your report discloses an offset to an operating expenditure(s) totaling \$41,623.60 from "Adrienne Arsht Performing Arts Center, LLC", "Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee" and "MG Trust"; however, your report(s) does not appear to disclose disbursements to these entities. Please provide clarifying information regarding this activity and amend your report(s) if necessary.
2. Schedule A supporting Line 15 of your report discloses an offset to an operating expenditure(s) totaling \$936.03 from "Citizens for Arlen Specter"; however, there are \$69.88 in disbursements to this entity disclosed on your disbursement schedule(s). Please provide clarifying information regarding this discrepancy and amend your report(s) if necessary.
3. Itemized disbursements must include a brief statement or description of why the disbursements were made. Please amend Schedule B supporting Line(s) 21(b) of your report to clarify the following description(s): "Political Consulting". For further guidance regarding acceptable purposes of disbursements, please refer to 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3).



- Your report disclosed certain categories of financial activity that have been reflected on the wrong lines of the Detailed Summary Page. In-kind contributions to affiliated committees should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule(s) B, supporting Line(s) 22 of the Detailed Summary Page. Contributions to federal candidates should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule(s) B, supporting Line(s) 23 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please refer to the instructions for each line when determining the proper categorization(s) for your next filing.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
