

This explanation is being filed in response to an inquiry from the PAC's reports analysts. ABC PAC filed an amendment to the May 2008 report on July 14. While the report included additional information about the independent expenditure as requested in a Request for Additional Information, the electronic version of the report inexplicably fails to reflect this information. Thus, we are resubmitting the information in this amendment based on the advice from the Reports Analysis Division. The independent expenditure for which payments are shown on this report was distributed in all 50 states and allocated equally among them. A 24 hour notice was filed for this even though it was not required by Advisory Opinion 2003-40. Further, because the primaries had been held in many states prior to the distribution of the ad, \$3,117.80 should have been shown for the remaining primaries (ID, IN, KY, MT, NC, NE, NM, OR, SD, WV) and \$12,471.20 should have been designated as for the general election. The per state allocation was \$311.78.
